Administrative Bylaw II—Election of Officers

Bylaw II, Section 1. Nominations

1. All nominations must be received in writing by the chair of the nominations committee. Nominations from the floor at the annual meeting may be accepted.
2. All nominations must be accompanied by a signed consent from the nominee, or where the nomination has arisen from the floor, verbal consent from the nominee.

Bylaw II, Section 2. Election

1. Election of the officers shall take place at the annual meeting.
2. An election for president-elect shall take place in even (numbered) calendar years.
3. Of the remaining council members, an election for four members shall occur in even (numbered) calendar years and for (the remaining) four in odd (numbered) calendar years.
4. Members of council shall elect a secretary and treasurer from the eight elected members. The election is to take place at the first business meeting of the council after the annual meeting.

Bylaw II Section 3. Voting

1. All practicing members of the College shall have a vote.
2. Every voting member shall be entitled to one vote with respect to business of the College.
3. Voting shall be done by secret ballot during the elections at an annual meeting.
4. A person qualified to vote at the annual general meeting of the college, but who is unable to attend, may appoint as proxy for casting a vote, a person who is entitled to vote.
5. No proxy appointed shall act for more than one absent member. The person so appointed shall be entitled to vote as proxy only if the written appointment as proxy signed by the person making the appointment is received by the secretary on or before the commencement of the Annual General Meeting.
6. A proxy form shall be mailed to each member with the notice of the annual general meeting.

Life and Honorary Memberships

Life membership in the College shall be:

1. Limited to former practicing members of the College who are retired from the practice of Physical Therapy and;
2. Granted by the Council in recognition or outstanding service to Physical Therapy in Saskatchewan.

Life membership entitles a person to the following privileges without payment of fees:

1. To have a voice, but not a vote, at the Annual and special meetings of the College;
 2. To be appointed to committees of the College;
 3. To receive a copy of College documents appropriate for distribution and;
 4. To receive the publications of the College.
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Honorary Membership shall be:

1. Limited to persons who are not Physical Therapists or are Physical Therapists registered outside Saskatchewan and;
2. Granted by the Council in recognition for distinguished service to the profession of Physical Therapy or for valuable assistance to Physical Therapy in Saskatchewan.

Honorary Membership entitles a person to the following privileges without payment of fees:

1. To have a voice, but not a vote at the annual and special meeting of the College;
 2. To receive a copy of College documents appropriate for distribution and;
 3. To receive the publication of the College.
