

### SCPT Proof of Professional Liability Insurance Form

Each physical therapist, in order to obtain a licence to practice, must carry professional liability insurance as stated in Bylaw XIV of the Saskatchewan Physical Therapists Act, 1998.

Proof of Professional Liability for a minimum of \$5,000,000.00 on any one patient/client or \$5,000,000.00 maximum for the policy year for each insurance individual is required as a condition of licensure.
